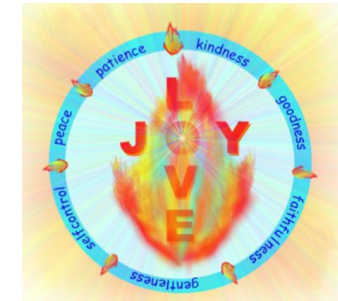
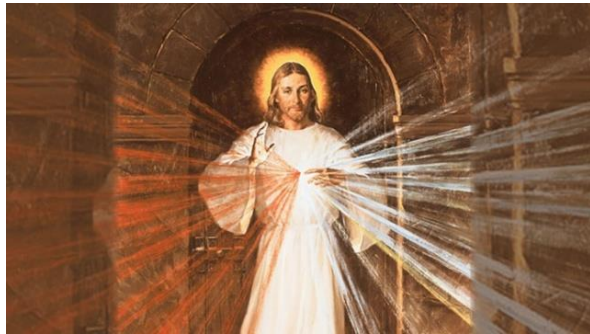


What we should know at the end of the unit
