Reception

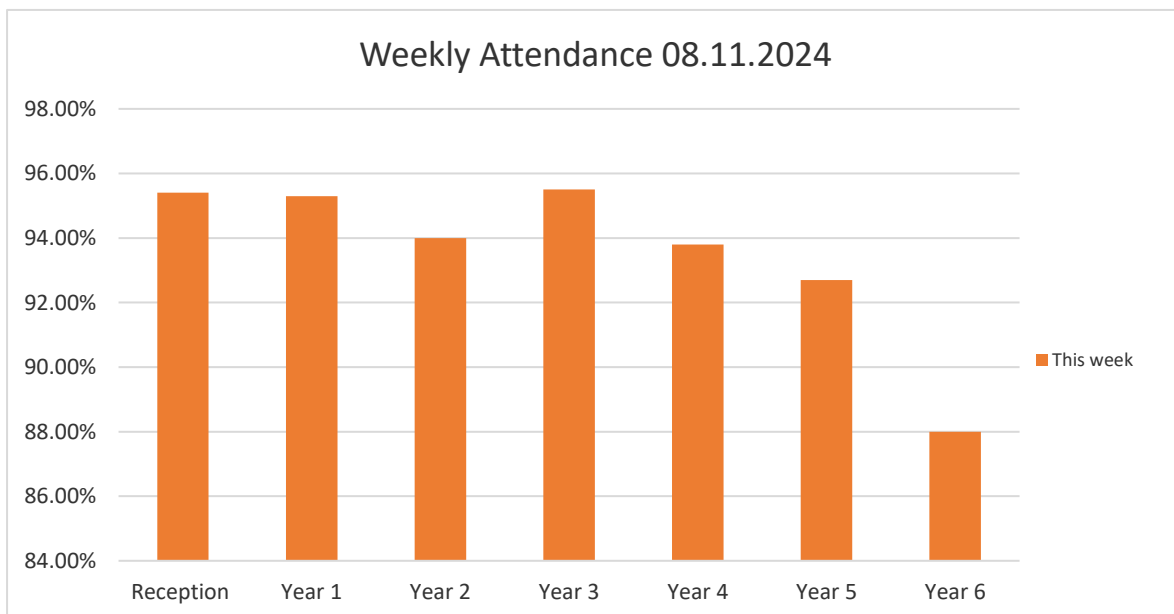
