## *Grateful...*

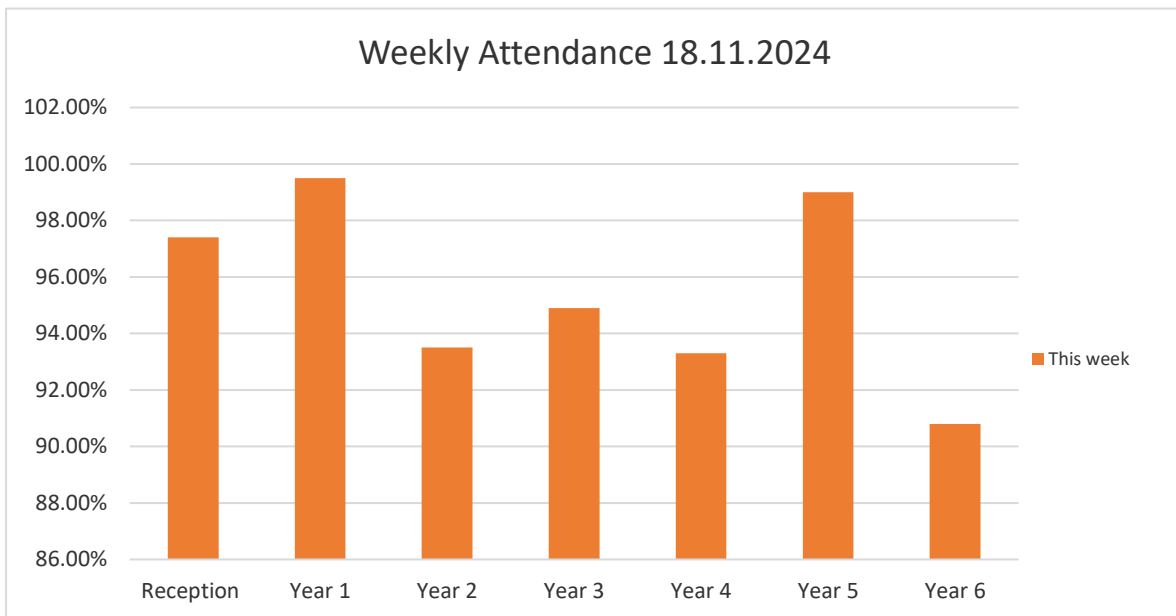

Well done **Year 1!** You have the highest attendance at 99.5% attendance this week!!



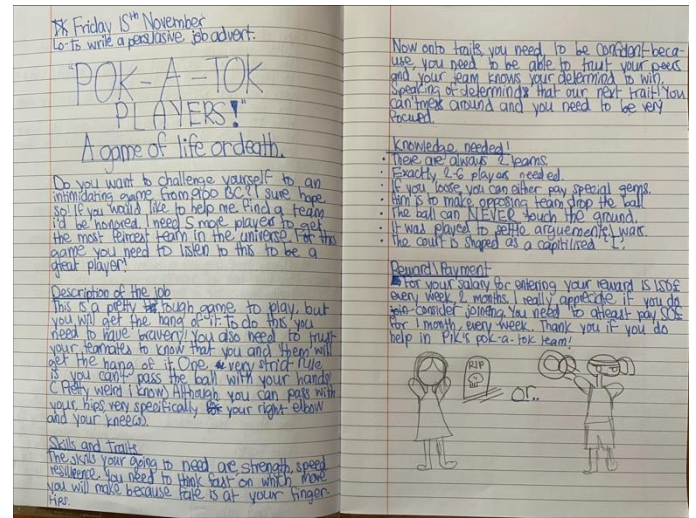
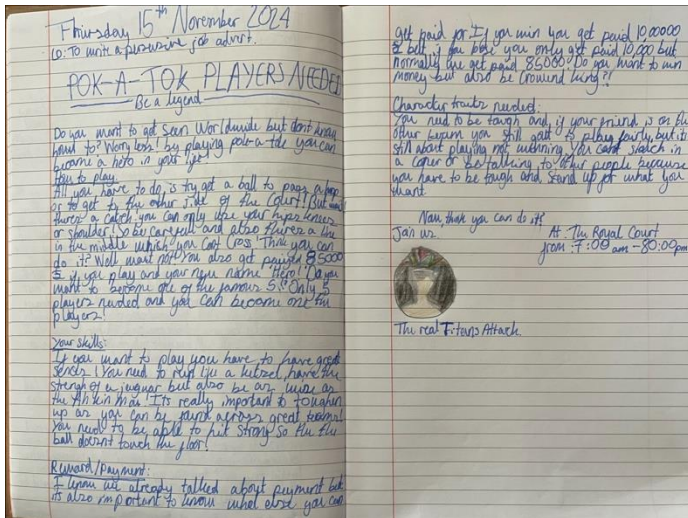
